

Outreach

Outreach is Northwest Youth Services' primary connection point for youth who are currently unhoused or disconnected from resources. Our goal is to connect youth with supportive relationships, provide basic needs items such as food, clothing, and safety gear for sleeping outside, and to work to connect youth with resources that can effectively end their experience of homelessness.

We do this in a few ways:

The Ground Floor Day-Use Center

Northwest Youth Services operates a drop-in space Monday-Friday. Youth come in to warm up, cool off, receive food and basic needs items such as hygiene products, socks, or other clothing, to rest, take a shower or use a computer. This has served as an excellent space for staff to get to know youth and support them in identifying resources they could benefit from and how to navigate and access them.

Outreach

Outreach services and activities are provided for youth at schools, libraries, and other locations where youth congregate throughout the county.
