

Housing

Northwest Youth Services' Housing Programs provide a spectrum of housing interventions available to youth ages 13-24. Each option includes case management and the development of a wrap-around team dedicated to supporting every youth in accessing and maintaining the type of housing they and their team feel they would be most successful in.

Transitional, Rapid Rehousing and Permanent Supportive Housing

Available to youth ages 18-21, our **transitional housing** program provides housing for up to 18 months. Youth in this program work with a case manager to identify a more permanent housing option. Youth pay into a housing savings account to save toward their next housing option.

Rapid rehousing is dedicated to youth who are moving out of unstable situations that resulted in them not having a place to live. Offering lease support, up to 6 months of housing financial assistance, deposit, and ongoing skill building in collaboration with Housing Case Managers.

Through 22 North, Northwest Youth Services provides 20 units of **permanent supportive housing** to young adults. Youth enrolled in this program often face the most barriers to other housing options and receive intensive case management and wrap-around services.

Emergency Housing

Our **PAD** (Positive Adolescent Development) program provides immediate shelter for minors. Staff are on-site 24 hours a day to support youth in crisis. In this program, youth work with a Case Manager to create a plan for obtaining stable housing before they exit.

Our **HULSY** (Housing Underserved Low-Income Youth) program provides housing for up to 90 days. The house is supported by staff on-site in the mornings and evenings, who focus on building safe relationships and community.
