What is a 'Love Warrior'?

We believe that folks in Whatcom and Skagit have justice and equity at the forefront of their minds. We know how much this community wants to make a difference. And we also understand that, when it comes to addressing systemic issues, it's easy to feel overwhelmed.

We're not going to sugarcoat it: youth houselessness is a problem. However, we believe it's a problem that can be solved. Everyone can play a role in ending youth houselessness, not just the wealthiest among us. There are lots of ways to step up, from volunteering to donating new and gently-used goods—but one of the easiest (and most effective) ways is to become a Love Warrior.

A Love Warrior is an individual deeply committed to their community, offering monthly donations that directly support our mission to eradicate youth houselessness in Whatcom and Skagit counties. The programs we offer extend beyond basic needs, encompassing a holistic, healing-centered care model, including initiatives like Queer Youth Services and Teen Court. Our approach is aimed at fostering long-term growth and resilience in young people, but to sustain these vital services, we rely on continuous support from the community.

According to Dr. Cornel West, "Love Warriors are those who have decided to cut radically against the grain and attempt to engage in forms of care and concern for others. They have a hypersensitivity to the suffering of others. They are willing to give one-self, to give whatever gifts one has cultivated to make the world a better place."
